## KEY ISSUES AND OBJECTIVES TO WHICH LEGRAND CONTRIBUTES

### INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENTS

**11.1** By 2030, ensure access for all to adequate, safe and affordable housing and basic services and upgrade slums

**11.2** By 2030, provide access to safe, affordable, accessible and sustainable transport systems for all, improving road safety, notably by expanding public transport, with special attention to the needs of those in vulnerable situations, women, children, persons with disabilities and older persons

**11.5** By 2030, significantly reduce the number of deaths and the number of people affected and substantially decrease the direct economic losses relative to global gross domestic product caused by disasters, including water-related disasters, with a focus on protecting the poor and people in vulnerable situations

Legrand has established partnerships with associations that work daily to improve housing for vulnerable individuals. For example, in the United States, Legrand, through its "Better Communities" program, collaborates with "Habitat for Humanity," "Building Homes for Heroes," and "Rebuilding Together" to assist veteran families, low-income families, and individuals with disabilities seeking to improve their living conditions. In France, Legrand supports the "Compagnons bâtisseurs" association, which helps financially disadvantaged families improve their homes, develop local support networks, and promote economic inclusion in the building sector through the Legrand Foundation.

In 2024, continuing the agreements signed in 2017 and 2021, Legrand renewed its commitment to Electricians Without Borders and the Crisis and Support Center (CDCS) of the French Ministry for Europe and Foreign Affairs for managing humanitarian emergency situations. Material and financial resources provided by the partners of this agreement are mobilized to reduce the number of people affected by natural disasters or emergency crises.
