Legrand is committed to achieving carbon neutrality by 2050, aligning with the Paris Agreement's 1.5°C target. By 2030, the company aims to reduce its Scope 1 and 2 emissions by 42% and its Scope 3 emissions by 25%, compared to the 2022 baseline. These commitments were validated by the Science Based Targets initiative in 2024. Legrand also encourages its key suppliers to adopt a formal target of reducing their CO2 emissions by 30% by 2030. Additionally, Legrand has established an internal carbon price to assess its investments, enhance its eco-design approach, and improve its logistics processes by reducing transport distances, optimizing truck loads, and minimizing air freight. Through its engagement with RE100, Legrand further strengthens its resilience to climate-related challenges.

To maximize awareness and engage its employees in positive environmental actions, Legrand organized two eco-gesture campaigns in 2021 and 2022 for all its staff. Simple reporting on straightforward actions enabled over a hundred employees to become eco-employees or eco-ambassadors. These campaigns are supported by training modules and dedicated days. Local initiatives are emerging in various regions worldwide, such as in the United Arab Emirates, where employees gather annually to clean a nearby site, or in countries where employees organize tree planting activities.

Energy efficiency principles are implemented in the construction, renovation, and maintenance projects of the Group's sites.
